- 1) NABARD invites sealed tenders for one of its Training Establishments namely National Bank Staff College (hereinafter referred to as "NBSC") situated at Sector- H, LDA Colony, Kanpur Road, Lucknow. NBSC intends to award work contract for Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of LED Street Lights at NBSC, Lucknow. For this, a closed tender among the empaneled contractors for the proposed work, under a single stage bidding process is being followed. Tender documents must be downloaded from the website www.nbsc.in under the head 'SITC of LED Street Lights at NBSC, Lucknow-closed tender among the empaneled contractors' as no hard copy will be given from at our end.
- 2) Contractors who are empaneled with NBSC, Lucknow for the General Electrical and HT electrical works shall only may tender for the work. The tenderers are advised to visit the site, conduct survey of the existing conditions so as to familiarize themselves with the nature of work to be carried out and get all clarifications necessary from the NBSC, Lucknow before quoting their rates.
- 3) Tender forms will be issued from **30/08/2019 to 09/09/2019** from the official website of NBSC, Lucknow. Tenders in prescribed forms for 'SITC of LED Street Lights at NBSC, Lucknow' superscribing the description of the work on sealed envelope and addressed by name to **The Principal**, National Bank Staff College (NBSC), Sector 'H', LDA Colony, Kanpur Road, Lucknow 226 012 will be received by the National Bank Staff College, (NBSC) upto 03.00 pm on **09 September 2019** and will be opened on the same day at **03.30 PM** in the presence of the authorized representative of the tenderers, who choose to be present. The Bank reserves the right to accept the lowest or any tender or to reject all of them. Validity of tendered rates shall be for 90 (Ninety) days from the date of opening. However, the rates quoted by the successful bidder would remain firm till the end of the contract period.
- 4) Tenders which do not fulfill all or any of the NBSC's conditions or are incomplete in any respect and tenders with the tenderer's own conditions other than those specified by NBSC are liable to be rejected.
- 5) The Tender (NIT) should be signed on each page, sealed and dated in all places in the documents.
- 6) This Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) shall also form part of the Tender Document.

7) Eligibility Criteria

Contractors who are empaneled for the work of General Electrical Works and HT Electrical Works for the period of 2019-2022 with NBSC, Lucknow shall only be eligible for the tender.

2. Attach technical specifications or product brochure detailing information of the product.
3. NBSC may ask the bidder to submit a sample of the quoted lights for review and technical scrutiny. Considering the wide difference in the technical parameters of the lights available in the market, any deviations in the technical parameters of the tender, shall be indicated in the compliance sheet by the bidders. Whether the deviations are within acceptable limits shall be decided by the technical committee of NBSC. Preference shall be given to the product which is technically closet to the benchmark wattage given above, vis-à-vis cost efficiency.

Eligibility:

1. Bidder should be empaneled with NBSC for 2019-21 for the category of General Electrical Works and HT Electrical Works.
2. Bidder should be authorized dealer/authorized stockist/**distributor** of the OEM for which the bidder is quoting. Bidders are requested to enclose valid certificate from the manufacturers as indicated in the Annexure 3.

Other Terms and Conditions:

1. This RFQ is a single bid process. There is no Tender Fee for the RFQ.
2. An amount of Rs.16,000/- shall be paid as EMD by the bidder along with RFQ.
3. Demand Draft/e-payment receipt towards the EMD, drawn in favour of National Bank Staff College, payable at Lucknow or directly credited to NBSC's Current Account Number-912020055439842 with Axis Bank, Main Branch, 31/93 MG Road, Near Governor House, Lucknow-226001 (IFSC Code- UTIB0000053). Payment through cash or cheque will not be accepted.
4. All pages of the RFQ and all supporting documents/certificate attached herewith shall be duly signed and sealed.
5. Sealed RFQ application shall be deposited in the 'Quotation Box' kept in the Administrative Block, National Bank Staff College, Lucknow, within the stipulated time/date only.

6. Full name, postal address, email address and telephone number of the bidder shall be written on the bottom left hand corner of the sealed covers.
7. Corrections, if any, in the quotation shall be duly authenticated with full signature. In case of any difference between the figures and the wordings, the wordings will be taken as the correct one.
8. RFQ received after the prescribed time and date will not be considered.
9. RFQ would remain open for acceptance for 90 days from the date of opening. For any clarifications please contact nbsc@nabard.org
10. If the successful bidder fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the RFQ, the security deposit shall be forfeited in full or in part as decided by the Competent Authority.
11. The Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified, defend and hold good the National Bank Staff College, Lucknow as per Annexure 2.
12. The National Bank Staff College does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any RFQ and reserves to itself the right to accept or reject any or all the RFQ, either in the whole or in part, without assigning any reasons for doing so.
13. Bidder has to undertake SITC work at NBSC, Lucknow campus. No extra freight charges or labour charges shall be entertained. All costs, taxes, levies, etc. shall be included in the bid.
14. Conditional Tenders/RFQ is liable to be rejected.
15. Penalty of 0.25% of incomplete amount of supply shall be levied in case of delay in successful completion of the supply, on per week basis.
16. EMD will be deposited with the NBSC till the completion of defect liability period (DLP) of 1 year from the date of virtual completion of the supply. No interest shall be paid on the said deposit. In case of faulty supply or faulty work or defects during the DLP, EMD shall be forfeited. The earnest money will be returned to the bidder if his RFQ is not accepted but without any interest, after finalisation of work order.
17. On receipt of intimation from the Employer of the acceptance of his / their RFQ, the successful bidder shall be bound to implement the contract and within fourteen days thereof the successful bidder shall be sign an agreement in accordance with the draft agreement and "the said Conditions" but the written acceptance by the National Bank Staff College, of a RFQ will constitute a binding contract, between the National Bank Staff College and the person so bidding, whether such formal agreement is or is not subsequently executed. (Annexure 1)

18. The contractor shall not assign the Contract. He shall not sublet any portion of the Contract except with the written consent of the Employer. In case of breach of these conditions, the Employer may serve a notice in writing on the contractor rescinding the Contract whereupon the security deposit shall stand forfeited to the Employer, without prejudice to his other remedies against the Contractor.
19. A Schedule of probable Quantities in respect of each work and Specifications accompany these Special Conditions. The Schedule of probable Quantities is liable to alteration by omission, deductions or additions at the discretion of the Employer. Each RFQ should contain not only the rates but also the value of each item of work entered in a separate column and all the items should be totaled in order to show the aggregate value of the entire RFQ.
20. The Contractor should note that unless otherwise stated the RFQ is strictly on item rate basis and his attention is drawn to the fact that rates for each and every item should be correct, workable and self-supporting. The quantities in the Schedule of Quantities approximately indicate the total extent of work but may vary to any extent and may even be omitted thus altering the aggregate value of the Contract. No claim shall be entertained on this account.
21. RFQ will be considered only from recognized bonafide contractors in the trade as given in the NIT.
22. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any compensation for any loss suffered by him on account of delays in commencing or executing the work, whatever the cause of delays may be, including delays arising out of modification to the work entrusted to him or in any sub-contract connected therewith or delays in awarding contracts for other trades of the project or in commencement or completion of such works or in procuring Government controlled or other building materials or in obtaining water and power connections for construction purposes or for any other reason whatsoever and the Employer shall not be liable for any claim in respect thereof. The Employer does not accept liability for any sum besides the tender amount, subject to such variations as are provided for herein.
23. Successful bidder shall indemnify NBSC by giving suitable Indemnity Bond as per NBSC's proforma attached herewith.
24. Payment shall be made to the successful bidder after successful completion for the work. No mobilization advance shall be paid by NBSC.
25. Any defects or shortcomings found during execution of work and during the defects liability period from the completion of the entire work shall be attended/rectified by the bidder without any extra cost to the Employer. In case of failure to do so within 10 days from such notice from the Bank, the Employer may get such rectification works carried

out through any other firm and expenditure incurred by the Bank shall be recovered from any money due to the Contractor at the cost and risk of the contractor.

26. Adequate care shall be taken to ensure safety of the workers employed by the bidder in execution of the work.
27. The Contractor shall bring to the attention of the Employer all notices required by any Acts, Regulations or Bye-Laws to be given to any Authority and pay to such Authority, or to any Public Office all fees that may be properly chargeable in respect of the works and lodge the receipts with the Employer.
28. The Contractor shall indemnify the Employer against all claims in respect of patent rights, and shall defend all actions arising from such claims' and shall himself pay all royalties, license fees, damages, cost and charges of all and every sort that may be legally incurred in respect thereof.
29. If any dispute, difference or question shall at any time arise between the parties as to the construction of this Agreement or concerning anything or as to the rights, liabilities and duties of parties hereunder except in respect of matters for which it is provided hereunder that the decision of the Employer or its Principal is final and binding, the same shall be referred to conciliation or arbitration after giving at least 30 days' notice in writing to the other (hereinafter referred to as the "Notice for Conciliation/Arbitration") clearly setting out the items of dispute to a Conciliator or Sole Arbitrator who shall be appointed as hereinafter provided. For the purpose of appointing the conciliator or the sole arbitrator referred to above, the Employer shall send to the Contractor within thirty days of the "Notice for Conciliation/Arbitration" a panel of three names of persons who shall be presently unconnected with the organization of the Employer or the Contractors.
30. The Conciliation/arbitration shall be governed by the Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1996 as in force from time to time. Where the parties do not agree with the Conciliator and appoint an Arbitrator(s) the award of the Arbitrator(s) shall be binding and final on the parties. It is hereby agreed that in all disputes referred to the Arbitrator, the Arbitrator shall give a separate award in respect of each dispute or difference in accordance with the terms of reference and the award shall be a reasoned award.
31. The fees, if any, of the Conciliator or the Arbitrator shall, initially be paid in equal proportion by each of the parties.
32. The work is liable to be technically audited by the Chief Technical Examiner (CTE) of the Central Vigilance Commission, Government of India from time to time. Any defects, improvements or testing etc., pointed out by the Chief Technical Examiner should be carried out by the contractor at his own cost and any deduction suggested by the CTE will be borne by the contractor.

33. The employer shall have a right to cause a technical examination and audit of works and the final bills of the contractor including all supporting vouchers, abstract, etc. to be made at the time of payment of the final bill. If as a result of his examination or otherwise any sum is found to have been overpaid in respect of any work done by the contractor under the contract, the contractor shall be liable to return the amount of overpayment and it will be lawful for the employer to recover the same from any sum or sums due to him and in any other manner legally permissible and if it is found that the contractor was paid less than what was due to him under the contract in respect of any work, executed by him under the contract, the amount of such under payment shall be duly paid by the employer.
34. Any sum of money due and payable to the contractor (including security deposit returnable to him) under this contract may be appropriated by NBSC and set off against any claim of NBSC for the payment of a sum of money arising out of or under any other contract made by the contractor with NBSC.
35. Testing of Materials: The contractors are required to submit samples of various materials, items, fittings, etc. for the approval of the Architect/ Consultant/ Bank. The materials of brand names, if any, given in the contract shall only be selected.
36. Co-ordination and Monitoring: The contractor's site supervisor/engineer will be coordinating and monitoring the project and report the progress to NBSC on weekly basis.
37. Substandard work and materials: If any work or materials used in the work is found to be unsound, imperfect or inferior from what is specified in the contract, the contractor will rectify or re-execute the work or remove the material within 10 days after receipt of written instructions. If the contractor fails to do so, the work shall get redone or rectified or the material replaced through any other agency by the Bank at the contractor's risk and cost.
38. Site order book: Site order book shall be maintained on the site for issuing instructions to the contractor in the course of day to day supervision of the work.
39. All the materials used in the work shall conform to the latest edition of BIS/ relevant Specifications and shall be of tested quality and subject to further tests, if required by NBSC, at no extra cost to NBSC.
40. Statutory deductions like income tax at source & surcharge thereon, works contract tax, service tax, etc. & surcharge thereon or other statutory deduction/s as applicable shall be deducted from bills /amounts payable to the contractor.

Articles of Agreement

ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____, between the National Bank Staff College, Lucknow, a training establishment of NABARD, having its Head Office at Mumbai - 400 051 (hereinafter called "the Employer") of the _____ the _____ one part and (hereinafter called "the Contractor") of the other part.

WHEREAS the Employer is desirous of carrying out the work of "Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of LED street light at NBSC, Sector-H, LDA Colony, Kanpur Road, Lucknow-226012" and has caused specifications describing the works to be done.

AND WHEREAS the said Specifications and the Schedule of Quantities have been signed by or on behalf of the parties hereto.

AND WHEREAS the Contractor has agreed to execute the work/s subject to the Conditions set forth herein and to the Conditions set forth in the Special Conditions and in the Schedule of Quantities and Conditions of Contract (all of which are collectively hereinafter referred to as "the said Conditions") the works shown upon the said Drawings and/or described in the said Specifications and included in the Schedule of Quantities at the respective rates therein set forth amounting to the sum as therein arrived at or such other sum as shall become payable thereunder (hereinafter referred to as "the said Contract Amount").

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS

1. In consideration of the said Contract amount to be paid at the time and in the manner set forth in the said Conditions, the Contractor shall upon and subject to the said Conditions execute and complete the work shown upon the said Drawings and described in the said Specifications and the Schedule of Quantities.
2. The Employer shall pay the Contractor the said Contract amount, or such other sum as shall become payable, at the times and in the manner specified in the said Conditions.
3. In the said Conditions there in before mentioned, the officer in charge of NBSC, Lucknow shall act on behalf of the Employer.
4. The said Conditions and Appendix thereto shall be read and construed as forming part of this Agreement, and the parties hereto shall respectively abide by, submit themselves to the said Conditions and perform the agreements on their part respectively contained in the said Conditions.
5. The agreement and documents mentioned herein shall form the basis of this Contract.
6. This Contract is neither a fixed lump sum Contract nor a Piece Work Contract but is a Contract to carry out the work in respect of "**Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of LED street lights at NBSC, Sector-H, LDA Colony, Kanpur Road, Lucknow-226012**" to be paid for according to actual measured

quantities at the rates contained in the Schedule of Rates or as provided in the said Conditions.

7. The Contractor shall afford every reasonable facility for carrying out of all works of other Contractors employed by the Employer. The Contractor shall make good any damages done to walls, floors, ceilings etc. after the completion of such works.
8. The Employer reserves to himself the right of altering the nature of the work by adding to or omitting any items of work or having portions of the same carried out without prejudice to this Contract.
9. Time shall be considered as the essence of this Contract and the Contractor hereby agrees to commence the work soon after the site is handed over to him or from tenth day after the date of issue of formal work order as provided for in the said Conditions whichever is later and to complete the entire work within 3 weeks subject nevertheless to the provisions for extension of time.
10. All payments by the Employer under this contract will be made only at Lucknow.
11. All disputes arising out of or in any way connected with this agreement shall be deemed to have arisen at Lucknow and only Courts in Lucknow shall have jurisdiction to determine the same.
12. That the tenderer has visited the site and fully understood the existing conditions of site for execution of work.
13. That the All parts of this Contract have been read by the Contractor and fully understood by the Contractor.
